

Mission: The goal of Love Your Neighborhood is to form and send young adults in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee to serve their local parishes and communities with the love of Jesus Christ through intentional commitment to service opportunities and leadership roles in their "neighborhood."

I. Relational Ministry Opportunities

Meet a New Friend

Vision: Meet with new young adults outside of Brew City Events to welcome them into the community and provide connection. Brew City staff will help you connect with new young adults.

- 1. Time Commitment: 1-2 hours/ meeting
 - a. Frequency: Ongoing, based on your availability

Small Group Leadership

Vision: Organize and host a small group at home or another location for young adults to provide consistent, intentional community and deepen discipleship.

- 1. Time Commitment: Varies depending on meeting frequency
 - a. 1.5 hours: Small group leader training
 - b. 2-3 hours: Preparation and facilitation of small group

II. Recurring Brew City Events

Cor Jesu

Vision: Weekly young adult prayer encounter with Mass, Adoration, Confessions, and a social. It runs entirely on volunteer efforts.

Roles: Volunteer needs vary throughout the year. If interested, Brew City staff will connect with you regarding current needs.

Brewing the Faith: "Grab a beer, hear a message, and meet your neighbor."

Vision: Brewing the Faith is an outreach event designed to draw new people into Catholic community through a witness to good community, healthy fun, and a simple, Gospel-focused message.

Roles:

- 1. Core team (8-12 people per location): serve as leaders for Brewing the Faith; create a welcoming environment focused on meeting new people and drawing them into fun and friendship
 - a. Time Commitment:
 - i. 3-hour training before first night of event
 - ii. 3 hours monthly (attend BtF each month, arriving at 6:30)
 - b. Optional: serve as MC/Master of Ceremonies (act as logistical leads for the night: handle transitions, manage schedule, and keep the program running on time)
 - i. Time Commitment: 30 min training on MC
 - 1. Specific training included in Core team training
 - 2. MC every other BtF
- 2. Speaker: Brewing the Faith talks are 20 minutes, testimony and gospel-based TED-style talks.
 - a. Time Commitment: 4 Hours/ Talk
 - i. 1.5 hours: talk preparation
 - ii. 2.5 hours: present at event
 - b. Speaker Expectations
 - i. Prepare, pray with, and practice talk with Brew City Staff
 - ii. Arrive early with the Core Team (6:30pm)
 - iii. Deliver talk and be open to feedback from the core team and/or local Brewing the Faith coordinator.
 - c. If you express interest, Brew City Staff will be in touch with further details on the discernment process.

III. Annual Brew City Events

Inheritance: "Step into the true, good, and beautiful."

Vision: Create an opportunity for young adults in Milwaukee and the broader region to encounter community on a large scale, experience God's love, and receive their inheritance as a beloved son or daughter of God.

Roles:

- 1. Logistics (12-16 people): help with parking, cleaning rooms, and helping people get where they need to be throughout the day.
 - a. Time Commitment: varies by role (15 min-2 hours per person)
- 2. Hospitality (14 people): welcome people to the conference, help lost things find their people, and work with Inheritance exhibitors and vendors.
 - a. Time Commitment: varies by role (2 hours—all day)
- 3. Food (12 people): help people get food and/or coffee all day!
 - a. Time Commitment: varies by role (2 hours-all day)
- 4. Liturgy (3 people): assist with liturgies and sacraments at Inheritance and clergy hospitality throughout the duration of the conference.
 - a. Time Commitment: varies by role (1 hour-all day)

Winter Weekend

Vision: A weekend retreat designed to build community and form participants in deeper prayer and conversion.

Roles:

- 1. Small group leaders: walk with a group of young adults of the same sex in similar age range through the weekend. Help them feel welcome, cared for, heard, and challenged.
 - a. Time Commitment: 1 hour meeting and retreat weekend availability
 - i. One evening training before retreat
 - ii. Attend entirety of retreat weekend

IV. Occasional Commitments

Media

Vision: Capture and spread the beauty of the Gospel and community through excellent photography and an engaging social media presence.

Roles:

- 1. Photographer: With direction and guidance from the Brew City Coordinator, photographer will take photos at one particular Brew City related event, such as Inheritance, Winter Weekend, Cor Jesu, Brewing the Faith, or other Brew City social; they will complete simple edits on photos and upload them to the Brew City gallery.
 - a. Event expectations:
 - i. Brewing the Faith 25 photos
 - ii. Inheritance 50 photos
 - iii. Winter Weekend 50 photos
 - b. Payment: Stipend or free event registration may be possible.
- 2. Social Media Coordinator: Work with Brew City Coordinator to help design and plan posts, stories, etc. related to Brew City events, community, and encouragement in relationship with God.
 - a. Time Commitment: 4 hours/month
