ROLE OF THE MISSIONARY

The role of Brew City Catholic Missionary is to evangelize in concert with the mission/vision of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. This means that their role is to be on mission for their particular campus, primarily as a relational minister to the students entrusted to their care; building relationships and walking with students. This relational ministry manifests itself largely in outreach, small group bible studies, and discipleship.

- Building strong relationships in every setting.
- Planning and leading encounter opportunities (outreach), small groups, discipleship groups or 1-1s.
- Inviting people into adventure, relationship, community, life with Christ, and leadership.
- Collaborating with campus ministry staff to assist as needed in events, retreats, service opportunities, etc...
- Actively investing in your community (Team, House, Staff, Students)
- Actively engaging in formation opportunities in summer and throughout year.
- Building and fostering your Mission Support Team (Fundraising)
- Other-ing (Additional aspects or tasks will come up - If you are unsure if it's something you should do, Ask!)

Team Leader additional Elements

- Act as primary point person for Missionary Team
- Liaison between Missionary Team and Campus Ministry Staff
- Oversee and Organize Team Schedule
- Support and Guide Teammates through regular touchpoint meetings
